## FINAL ORDER CONSOLIDATING THE REAGAN RANCH (BOSSIER SAND) FIELD INTO THE BALD PRAIRIE (CV CONSOLIDATED) FIELD ROBERTSON, LEON AND LIMESTONE COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 13, 2002, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.
