Comments concerning proposed rulemakings

Consider changing the minimum production to at least 250 mcf/d. Small operators cannot afford the additional expenses to maintain the weatherization standards proposed. Production at 15 mcf/d doesn't amount to much especially after line loss and the midstream expenses. We already afford to sell the natural gas at such a small rate. After compression, our profit goes negative right now without the additional costs to inject methanol and purchase insulation blankets. Why such a huge fine? - there is no way that a company our size could rebound after receiving a hefty fine. Let's be realistic, you will drive more of us out of business. The gas purchasers have the low volume fee for several years now, that is an indicator after all of the expenses of gathering and processing the gas is uneconomical. Ask the purchasers and they will tell you what that production level is.
